Barbeque Operation Guideline

PURPOSE:

To ensure safe operations of a barbeque, the following necessary precautions shall be followed:

- 1. Never attempt to relocate a grill once it has been lit or a grill that is hot.
- 2. Portable grills should be used on firm, flat, stable surface.
- 3. NEVER grill inside, under a tent or awning, or on a combustible balcony. Grilling on noncombustible surfaces such as concrete or asphalt is preferred.
- 4. No accelerants will be used to ignite charcoal/wood grills. Use only self-starting charcoal.
- 5. All coals will be disposed of in a safe manner. It is recommended that a metal can be used for this process.
- 6. No grills will be used within ten feet of any building or combustible material.
- 7. An approved fire extinguisher will be readily available when grilling is in progress.
- 8. All grills will be cleaned and inspected prior to use.
- 9. Never leave the grill unattended.
- 10. Turn off the gas to the grill when you are finished.
- 11. All portable grills will be stored properly, (no propane bottles may be stored inside any Baylor building)
- 12. Propane grills at Teal & Earle will only be used under supervision by CLL professional staff.
